### Fully Inclusive

Whilst on one of our fully inclusive group tours, all you need to do is relax and enjoy your experiences, knowing that all expenses that can be pre paid have been included in your initial tour cost. Wendy Wu Tours prides itself on 'no hidden extras' and therefore all of our group tours are inclusive of everything, from international economy flights, accommodation, meals (excluding drinks), National Escort and local guides (depending on group size), entrance fees and visa fees for South African passport holders. It also means that the start date of the tour is the date of departure from South Africa and consequently the end date of the tour is the date of arrival back in South Africa. If time permits, your National Escort may suggest optional tours/sightseeing that is in addition to the standard sightseeing and will compliment your time in that city. Such options are at an additional cost and prices range from 70 to 200 Yuan per person and involve experiences such as a rickshaw ride through a Hutong District in Beijing, or a ride on the Maglev train in Shanghai.

### Single Travellers

Many single travellers prefer to have a private room during their group holiday and a single supplement is charged in those circumstances. At Wendy Wu Tours we understand that many single travellers would happily share a room

and avoid paying an additional supplement if they had a partner to share with. If you are one of those people Wendy Wu Tours will match you up with another like minded single traveller on your tour and neither of you will pay the single supplement. However, if we are unable to find another traveller for you to share with, Wendy Wu Tours will waive the single hotel supplement (rail and cruise supplements are additional and cannot be waived), thereby saving you the additional cost.

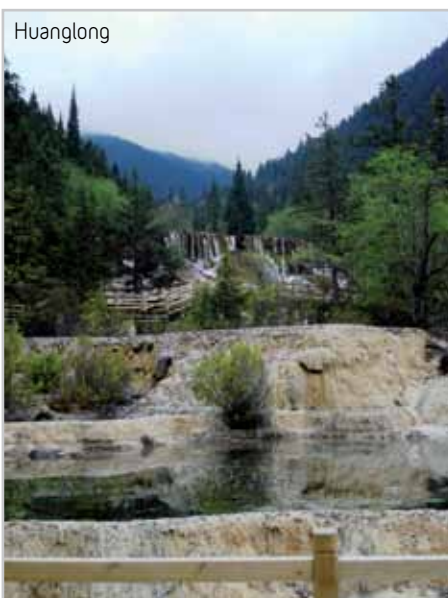

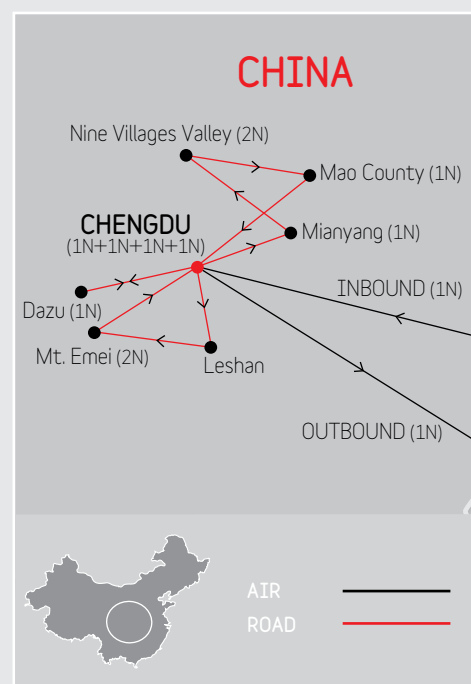

# Introduction to Vietnam

Shaped like a giant 'S', Vietnam covers an area of over 330,000sq km stretching south from the Chinese border along the east coast of the Indochina Peninsula. The country comprises a complex geography with soaring mountains, fertile delta plains, ancient forests filled with exotic fauna, winding rivers and long sandy tropical beaches. Although entirely within the tropics, the diversity of the geography of Vietnam produces enormous climatic variations with the north of the country having cold, humid winters and warm, wet summers, whilst the south is generally warm all year with a monsoon season from May to November.

**Time** GMT + 8 hours (In general terms that means Vietnam is approx 6 hours ahead of South Africa).

**Language** Official language is Vietnamese. English is widely spoken as is French by the older generation.

**Currency** Vietnamese Dong (VND) ZAR1 = 2355 VND (approx)

**Climate** Vietnam is located in a sub-tropical climatic zone with the weather pattern roughly split into 3 different zones. The north has a distinct summer and winter with the high humidity monsoon/wet season lasting from May to October. The centre of the country experiences a long dry season lasting from January to the end of September before having its compact wet season. The south has a tropical weather pattern with 2 distinct seasons, wet and dry with the high humidity monsoon lasting from May to November. During the wet season in the south, the rainfall is usually daily with heavy but short lived downpour in the afternoon. The best times to visit Vietnam are in the months of November through to March. April, May, September and October are also popular, though Vietnam can be at its most attractive during the monsoon due to lush growth of the vegetation.

Due to the unpredictable climate changes around the world we strongly recommend you check the current weather at your destination prior to departing in order to pack accordingly.



## Entry Requirements

Passports must be valid for 6 months beyond the length of stay. Visas are required for South African passport holders, the price of which is already included in the fully inclusive price of all our group tours (providing all applications are received by Wendy Wu Tours within the required visa processing time frame).

# Introduction to Cambodia

One of the most breathtaking sights a traveller to Cambodia will experience are the Temples of Angkor. Many visitors may never intend to go beyond these magnificent temples; however, they are soon captivated by other parts of this charismatic and welcoming country. Cambodia is blessed with unspoilt beaches, pristine forests and beautiful colonial cities like Phnom Penh, Battambang and Kep. It is also the gentle, polite and friendly nature of the Khmer people which makes Cambodia such a memorable destination.

**Time** GMT + 8 hours (In general terms that means Cambodia is approx 6 hours ahead of South Africa).

**Language** Khmer is the official language but English is widely spoken in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap, followed by French which is becoming increasingly popular.

**Currency** The local currency is the Riel (KHR) but the US Dollar is used in all transactions with Riel only used as change for less than a US dollar. USD1 = 4000 Riel (approx)

**Climate** Cambodia's climate follows the monsoon cycle and is warm to hot year round. Cambodia's southwest monsoon (wet season) lasts from May to October bringing tropical rains and high humidity. Rainfall is highest May to June and September to October. During this period the temples are surrounded by lush tropical vegetation and there are fewer tourists. The northwest monsoon (dry season) lasts from November to April and spreads dry weather and high temperatures throughout the country. The best time to visit, is during the cooler months of the dry season (December and January). Although daytime temperatures can remain high, nights become much more tolerable. However, Cambodia can be visited at any time of the year.

Due to the unpredictable climate changes around the world we strongly recommend you check the current weather at your destination prior to departing in order to pack accordingly.



## Entry Requirements

Passports must be valid for 6 months beyond the length of stay. Visas are required for South African passport holders and can be obtained on arrival. 2 passport photos and approx USD25.00 per person is required.
